The conference has likewise invited almost 40 speakers from 17 countries namely: China, Costa Rica, Germany, Indonesia, Japan, Kazakhstan, Malaysia, Mexico, Nepal, Philippines, Singapore, Switzerland, South Korea, Thailand, Vietnam, United States, and United Kingdom. This year will also provide an avenue for more than 100 research papers to be presented in the 20 simultaneous panel sessions for the two-day conference. EROPA Participates Virtually in the 21st Committee Session of UN CEPA



April 4-8, 2022 – The United Nations Committee of Experts of Public Administration (UN CEPA) recently held its 21st Committee Session on a hybrid set-up at the UN Headquarters in New York and at Zoom Video Communications. The EROPA Secretariat was part of the official participants of the Committee Session as Observer Institution.

The five-day session with the theme, *Transforming Institutions and Governance to Build Forward Better Towards 2030* discussed pressing issues on: 1) Building strong institutions to

combat climate change and its impacts and for the sustainable management, protection and restoration of natural resources; 2) Issues of governance and institution-building in conflict-affected countries; 3) Application of the principles of effective governance for sustainable development at the subnational level; 4) Issues in public financial management and budgeting for the SDGs; 5) Dialogue with voluntary national review countries and voluntary local review cities on institutional aspects of SDG 16; and 6) Issues in digital government. EROPA Co-organizes with Kasetsart University, Thailand – Sustainable Development, Social Sciences, and Public Administration: Old Wine in New Bottles?

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
The Kasetsart University successfully 2022 Conference, in organized its partnership with EROPA, on the Roles of Sciences Sustainability Social in Transformation in the Global South. The Kasetsart University also invited Dr. Mechai Viravaidya, former member of the Senate in Thailand who promoted condoms, family planning and AIDS awareness in country, as one of its keynote speakers. At this conference, plenary speakers gave a cursory review of sustainable development since the 20th century. Afterward, they tackled the role sciences in of social addressing development challenges and how to make them tenable in the long term. In the realm of public administration, it is about governance where the government, civil society, businesses, and the citizenry collaborate to solve collective problems.



The Global South, while lacking the technological expertise and industrial capacity of the developed world, has exerted significant efforts in mitigating global problems. Initiatives such as joint capacity building, environmental protection, digital governance, food security, women empowerment, and the like can help ensure that meaningful progress will be made and not at the expense of the natural environment. The presentations also highlighted that corporate social responsibility and multilateralism are among the best solutions we may have in the face of multipronged problems that roam this world. International cooperation, political will, localized responses, and people's participation are imperative if we have a fighting chance to solve global challenges. To borrow a statement from Harari, just as the ancient people of Egypt came together to harness the power of the Nile River, the world community must do it again in the face of existential threats in this age.

EROPA Participates in Webinar on Reducing Education Inequality Organized by KPI Thailand



May 26, 2022 – The King Prajadhipok's Institute in Thailand successfully organized a webinar on the **Exchange with Local** Administration Model in Managing Education to Reduce Education Inequality where EROPA participated as one of its plenary speakers.

In his presentation on the Practices in Addressing Higher Education Inequity in the Philippines, Dr. Brillantes, Jr. provided a glimpse of the context of Philippine higher education institution in terms of its legal support per the Constitution and its standing with other HEIs in the region. He then presented efforts of the government and State Universities and Colleges (SUCs) in the Philippines such as the University of the Philippines in addressing education inequality. These include the University of the Philippines Socialized Tuition Fee System and the recently enacted Republic Act No. 10931 or the Universal Access to Quality Tertiary Education Act (2015). He also emphasized that the government and HEIs should always be reminded of the discussion on access vs. quality of higher education in the Philippines.

EROPA Meets with American Society for Public Administration (ASPA)

June 3, 2022 - EROPA met with the American Society for Public Administration (ASPA) through its Executive Director Dr. William P. Shields, Jr. to forge possible collaborations with the esteemed organization. Initial agreements include the participation of ASPA in the 2022 EROPA Conference. Dr. Shields, Jr. will be one of the plenary speakers on the Plenary Governance on Local and Leadership along with speakers from Malaysia, Philippines, Thailand. and Vietnam.



ASPA likewise agreed to submit manuscript to the Asian Review for Public Administration (ARPA) journal of EROPA focusing on the COVID-19 pandemic response of the United States of America. ASPA continues to be one of the very relevant and prestigious organization that caters both practitioners and academicians in the field of public administration. This partnership will indeed benefit EROPA in terms of learning strategies to better engage its members and expand its network in the Asia Pacific region.

Chandler Academy of Governance - EROPA Collaboration



May 30, 2022 - The EROPA Secretariat conducted the meeting with the Chandler Institute of Governance (CIG), through its Chandler Academy of Governance (CAG), to discuss possible areas for partnership of the two institutions. Present in the meeting were Mr. Kenneth Sim, Dean of the CAG, Ms. Victoria Giaever-Enger, Mr. Akshat Garg, Ms. Nicole Seh, and Ms. Audrey Chan.

The meeting initiated plans for collaborations with CAG including among others the conduct of the Global Survey on Public Sector specifically the National Government Training Institutions (NGTIs). The partnership includes consultation on the survey tool as well as dissemination of the online survey to the EROPA Group Members that qualifies as NGTIs. The global survey seeks to better understand the challenges and opportunities that NGTIs face in delivering high-quality and practitioner-oriented training to support public sector capability development. EROPA in TURN ON FEDERALISM Series of 50 Shades of Federalism and Hanns Seidel Foundation – To Go Federal or Not? Federalism Discourses in the Philippines



The discussions of federalism in the Philippines are not new. This was the main point raised by Dr. Brillantes, Jr. in the forum organized by the 50 Shades of Federalism and Hanns Seidel Foundation. Devolution and decentralization initiatives have been present long before the implementation of the Local Government Code in 1991. Laws such as the Republic Act 2370, 3950 (Barrio Charter Act), Republic Act 5185 (Decentralization Act of 1967), and the Batas Pambansa Bilang 337 (National Law No. 337 or the Local Government Act of 1983), to name a few. The country's decades-long decentralization experiences are valuable once the country decides on a federal shift. There was a cursory review of prominent Filipinos that contributed to federalism debates. Several issues were discussed, including the national government's centralist tendencies, elite capture, politico-administrative structures, absorptive capacities, and more.

The Philippines must build upon previous decentralization efforts, learn from other countries, especially federations, and take a deep, objective introspection before institutionalizing a federal government. To be successful, various countries contemplating federalism must chart their own federal model, suited to their political, social, and historical context. Ultimately, federalism is not an end in itself but a means to empower subnational governments and people's participation and enhance inclusive development.

The Hanns Seidel Foundation-Philippines, together with the Pimentel Institute of Leadership and Governance, will co-organize a plenary session on managing the pandemic under a federal form of government in the 2022 EROPA Conference.



Dr. Brillantes, Jr., who served as one of the plenary speakers last June 3, 2022, remarked that "we have to demand accountability from those who lead us... Civic education is about participation, accountability, and, very importantly, critical thinking. Do not just accept things as they are, especially in this day and age of social media. Always validate. Always question." Look at the question behind the question." Always dare to question authority.

Its eternal duty is to help implement the policies of a sitting government. At the same time, it is largely distanced from the whims of politics.



EROPA Participates in PSPA's 2nd National Student Webinar

April 30, 2022 – EROPA served as one of the plenary speakers to the Philippine Society for Public Administration's (PSPA's) 2nd National Student Webinar, in collaboration with the Cebu Normal University and Tarlac State University, focusing on the recent national elections last May 2022. The webinar titled, "Y-Click: Educate and Assess to Elect the Best," provided a platform to help and educate the youth about the importance of voting and how cyber political engagements affect the and civic consciousness, especially of the youth sector. EROPA was joined by Dr. Maria Lourdes Turalde-Jarade, Convenor of the Kawani Kontra Daya, a nongovernment organization that served as one of the election watchdogs in the Philippines; Mr. Marion Joseph Villar of the YouthLED; and Dr. Roselle Jardin of Cebu Normal University.

Dr. Brillantes, Jr. emphasized in his presentation the importance of voter's education and the role of the youth in the national and local elections. Given that a huge portion of the voting population is composed of the youth sector and first-time voters, the webinar provided some guidance and reminders to scrutinize all their prospect candidates, and review their platforms and its alignment to the national development agenda of the country.

Almost 500 participants attended the webinar and most of the attendees were first time voters and undergraduate students of public administration and political science.


